




CLEAN WATER FOR RWANDA



The “Rwanda Clean Water Project” has been developed by *Insieme per la Pace* Association for several savannah villages in the Nyagatare district of the Umutara region.

This project secures better hygienic conditions for long term economic and rural development of the region.



Thanks to these solar water pumps the children can regularly attend the school. Many people of the region witnesses a better wellbeing not wasting their time and effort in searching for clean water.



In this project we only use solar hydraulic pumps.





All installed pumps have the same principle:




Solar pannels

Technical Schema:



Drinking fountains stand normally at ca 10 meters from the pump.



Troughs are just a bit more fare away.



A local community committee chooses and pays a responsible to manage the plant. Every habitant of the village provides a monthly contribution of FRW 500.- (CHF 0.50) to pay the guardian salary and the maintenance of the plant.

The drinking water is free



All taps are closed
between 11:00 and
14:00 and during the
night to guarantee the
proper plant operation
and tank filling.



Since 2011, *Insieme per la Pace Association*, has invested in this project CHF 1'560'000 and built 64 plants for the benefit of more than 54'000 people. CHF 1.610.595.-.
